Courtbrack Student Accommodation, acquired by Mary Immaculate College in Feb. 2003, is a purpose built unit providing accommodation for first-year undergraduate students, male and female. The complex, situated on Courtbrack Avenue, is approximately a five-minute walk to the Mary Immaculate College campus. Courtbrack provides quality self-catering accommodation in a safe and secure environment at an affordable price. Room rates and charges for the academic year 2026/2027 are as follows:

Standard Single Room: €4,760 (payable in two equal installments or monthly)

Deluxe Single: €5,126 (payable in two equal installments or monthly)

Twin Room: €3,660 per person (payable in two equal installments or monthly)

Full Academic Year payment discount available

How to Book

All applicants must have MIC listed on their CAO form. Booking forms are available from the college website at www.mic.ie. The complex can be viewed by appointment. All fully completed booking forms will be included in a lottery that will be drawn in January 2026. The first eighty forms will be contacted and offered the opportunity to pay a deposit of €850 (more details below) or go onto the waiting list with no deposit paid. <a href="Payment details are listed on the end of the booking form (number 2). All booking forms will be added to the list once the booking deposit has been received. If you do not receive confirmation by email of your payment, please contact the accommodation office. Rooms cannot be held for second round offers or rechecks. All bookings must be for the full academic year. Students and their guarantor will be required to sign a Licence Agreement for this period (a copy of the Licence Agreement and Residents' Handbook is available on request). Booking cancellations caused by failure to secure qualification points to study at Mary Immaculate College or if on the waiting list and a room cannot be offered will incur an administrative charge of €100. Cancellations for any other reason will result in the complete forfeit of the €850 deposit.

Booking/Security Deposit

Following the lottery in January, successful prospective student residents will be contacted with the necessary details required to make the deposit payment by bank transfer to Mary Immaculate College.

The booking/security deposit is €850. The breakdown of the deposit is as follows;-

- A security/damage deposit of €250 refundable minus damages, ESB overspends, fines, and missing items at the end of the academic year.
- A non-refundable utilities charge of €300. This covers the cost of such payments as cable TV, unlimited internet access, refuse collection, housekeeping service, etc.
- A non-refundable allowance of €300 for ESB usage. Residents are responsible for their own energy
 usage but will be advised on their electricity spend throughout their tenancy. Should there be an overspend, it will be deducted from the security/damage deposit.
