Booking Information (Bookings may be made immediately)













Mary Immaculate College on-campus Halls of Residence are an extension of the main college building. Spaced out over three floors they provide accommodation for 43 **female students** on a single room <u>bed and breakfast</u> basis. Facilities and services provided by the residences include the following;-

- Study bedrooms equipped with study desk, chair and overhead shelving, wardrobe, chest of drawers and vanity unit. Please note, students should provide their own bed linen and towels.
- · Bathrooms, shower rooms and toilets are available on each floor.
- Lounge / Kitchenette area located on each floor and equipped with TV, refrigerator, kettle and micro- wave (please note, this area is suitable for the preparation of light snacks only).
- Coin operated self-service launderette on each floor.
- The canteen provides hot food, drinks and snacks from 8.30am to 4pm, Monday to Thursday and from 8.30am to 2pm Friday.
- 24 hour security service.
- Housekeeping service for communal areas.

Room Rates and charges for the academic year 2019/2020 are as follows;-

Study Bedroom:

€3,200 payable in two equal installments of €1,600

Including a breakfast allowance of €684.00

Booking/ Security Deposit:

<u>Please contact the MIC Accommodation Office 061-302500 before you transfer the €750 Deposit.</u> Payment of a booking/security deposit of €750 is required in order to secure accommodation. The breakdown of the deposit is as follows;-

- A security / damage deposit of €250 refundable minus damages and missing items etc. at the end of the Academic year.
- A non-refundable utilities charge of €500. This covers the cost of electricity, refuse collection, housekeeping service, TV, etc. (no additional charges apply).

How to Book

Application forms are available from the Accommodation Office or at <u>WWW.MIC.UL.IE</u> Viewing is recommended and can be arranged by appointment.

Bookings will be allocated on a first come first served basis and a room will be deemed to have been provisionally secured only after we receive the booking form, your bank details and the deposit has been paid by bank transfer. The payment details are at the end of the booking form (number 4). Rooms can't be held for second round offers or rechecks. **All bookings must be for the full academic year**. Students and their guarantor will be required to sign a Licence Agreement for this period (a copy of the Licence Agreement is available on request). Booking cancellations caused by a failure to secure qualification points to study at Mary Immaculate College or, on the waiting list and a room cannot be offered will incur an administrative charge of €100, cancellations for any other reason will result in the complete forfeit of the €750 deposit.
