## **Terms of Reference**

The Research Committee is charged with providing active and practical support for academic staff research and postgraduate research within the College. This includes:

- to help guide the research and postgraduate components of future College development and diversification
- to review and advise on research and postgraduate policy matters
- to advise on matters relating to research development in the College
- to advise on matters relating to postgraduate research and taught programmes
- to underwrite the highest quality assurance standards in research and postgraduate work
- to assist where required with academic and routine practical services to the Research & Graduate School
- to assist with identifying and accessing sources of external funding for research and postgraduate projects
- to develop strategies to increase academic staff engagement in research and publication
- to develop strategies to increase postgraduate numbers and postgraduate programmes
- to identify and foster potential research collaboration within the College, including inter-disciplinary research
- to help organise Research & Graduate School seminars of generic value to staff and postgraduate students
- to promote inter-institutional and inter-organisational research links in Ireland and elsewhere
- to support the integration of research and teaching at undergraduate and postgraduate levels within the College
