

Bonaventure Trust Fee Remissions for the Certificate in Christian Leadership in Education Programme:

Ten Fee Remissions to the value of €375 each (50% of the fees payable) are available from the Bonaventure Trust to successful applicants for the Certificate in Christian Leadership in the year 2020-21.

In order to be eligible for consideration for one of these scholarships one must:

1. Be a qualified teacher (primary or secondary) and hold an honours primary degree at a 2.2 level of award or higher;
2. If a primary teacher, show that one has a consistently high level of achievement in the Certificate in the Teaching of Religious Education; if a secondary teacher hold at least a 2.2. honours level in the HDE/PME;
3. Demonstrate a strong personal and professional motivation for undertaking the programme in a letter to the Course Director;

Having submitted your application form for the programme, which you can download from this webpage, you should write a separate letter of application to be considered for the Remission of Fees, offered by the Bonaventure Trust and address this letter to the Course Coordinator. eugene.duffy@mic.ul.ie and copied to deirdre.franklin@mic.ul.ie This letter should indicate why you should be considered eligible for consideration.

Please note that the granting of fee remissions will be determined by the Bonaventure Trust whose decision in this matter will be final. Remissions will be made payable by the Trust directly to the students concerned only on successful completion of the programme.
