

The Faithful Companions of Jesus bursaries for the MA in Christian Leadership in Education 2023



Up to Six FCJ scholarships funded by The Faithful Companion of Jesus Sisters are available for the taught Master's programme (part-time) that will commence in the Summer Semester of 2023. The scholarships are worth €7,050 each, covering course fees.

Awards will be made on the following basis:

- (1) Academic Qualifications
- (2) A Personal Statement in which candidates demonstrate:
 - a. The benefit of becoming a FCJ scholar to her/him personally and to the teaching profession;
 - b. How they will extend themselves beyond their course of studies to become active in advancing Catholic Education;
- (3) Two references that support the candidates' applications.

Awards will be adjudicated by a panel established by MACLE programme coordinator and this panel will decide on the successful candidates based on the extent to which candidates meet the above criteria. In the first instance the award will be used to pay course fees, currently €3525 p.a. for two years.

How to Apply

Candidates must:

- (1) Satisfy requirements for admission to the Taught MA programme;
- (2) Demonstrate in a Personal Statement
 - a. how being a FCJ scholar will benefit her/him personally and the teaching profession;
 - b. how s/he will extend themselves beyond their course of studies to become active in advancing Catholic Education;
- (3) Not hold any other bursaries or awards associated with this programme of studies.
- (4) Submit the names and contact details of two referees.

Candidates may be called for an online interview as part of final selection.

Final submission date is June 1 2023
