



Four Year B.Ed. and B.Ed. & Psychology

The Extended Placement is scheduled in the autumn semester of Year 4 and is the final placement undertaken by students.

- Two three-week teaching blocks, the latter block must be in an Infant class
- Teaching is preceded by two weeks of Whole School engagements. Students undertake a range of teaching initiatives in a range of classes, as can be facilitated by the school.
