PLEASE NOTE: Non-EU programmes of study are not grant-aided. I.e., the student will not receive a monetary grant from the EU for study outside of the EU at the destinations below. You must fully fund your own mobility to a non-EU destination. [Funding for the UK may be available subject to availability of funding and number of applications].

Timely visa applications for non-EU countries are the responsibility of the student. The International Office does not have any direct contact or influence with the individual Embassies. Listed university options are subject to institution exchange balances and may not be available every year.

To be considered for nomination minimum QCAs apply: BEd and BEd International students must achieve a minimum of 2.8 in their 2nd year autumn exams, BA and BA ECCE and B.Sci students must achieve a minimum of 2.6 in their 2nd year autumn exams. Applications will not be processed for students who do not meet their required minimum QCA. For B.SC in psychology students the majority of non-eu partners we have teach psychology.
