- **Tip:** A PIN number is required to access this feature. Please collect this from either of the Library Issue Desks on presentation of your ID card.
- Select the **My Account** link on the top of the catalogue page.
- From here you can view your current loans, reservations and charges

Renewing your Loans

- Select the **My Account link**.
- View your loans. Tick the ones you want to renew and click on the **Renew Loan** button.
- You can renew a loan unless it is reserved by another borrower.
- It is not possible to renew 4 hour loans, 3 day or 1 day loans.
- Contact the library if there are difficulties renewing you loans.

Reserving a Loan

- You can only reserve General Lending & 3 day loan items that are on loan. It is not possible to reserve 4 hour, or 1 day loans.
- Select the **Reserve this item** button and follow the instructions.
- You will be notified by college email when the item is available for you.

Searching for books/AV material

- Use the library catalogue to:
 - Find the location of Library resources, i.e. books, e-books, AV Material.
 - Check your Library Account.
 - Reserve or renew your loans.
- The catalogue is available on any PC with internet access either
 - through the library webpage or at <http://capitadiscovery.co.uk/mic/>
- Type the author and/or the title into the search box.
- A list of results will appear.

Check Availability Save

- Click on the button **Check Availability**.
- Note the **Location** of the item. If it is located in one of our stores (Store - Treaty or Store - Dock Road) ask a member of staff about retrieving it. Items from Thurles library must be borrowed from and returned to Thurles library. All other items are shelved in the main library at a designated shelfmark.

- Look under **Status** to see whether the item is on loan or on the shelves.
- Note the **Shelfmark**. This is the number at which the item is shelved.

Searching for E-Books

- Type the author and/or the title into the search box.
- Click **Connect to Ebook**
- Enter your username and password

Searching for a Journal

- On the library Homepage, select **A-Z of Journals**. Contains both MIC print and e-journals.
- Type the journal title into the search box.
- Select link for the relevant year.

Electronic School Textbooks

Electronic version of textbooks. Also includes audio, video, printable and interactive resources

- Select **Electronic Resources**
- Select **Electronic School Textbooks**

Databases

- To choose a particular Database, select **Online Databases** on the library Homepage
- Select the letter from the alphabetical listing. Some databases provide brief details (abstracts) of articles such as author, title and a summary; others provide the entire article (full-text).
