
**Glossary:**

An elaboration as to what is meant by the headings in question 2	
<b>Content</b>	Syllabus and learning outcomes
<b>Difficulty</b>	Modules are designed to provide a challenge, but is this module unmanageably difficult?
<b>Resources</b>	Books, journals, equipment, software, computers etc. available to support the module
<b>Delivery</b>	The way the module is taught – e.g. lectures, tutorials, labs, problem-based learning, self-directed learning, online learning etc.
<b>Assessment Model</b>	The way the module is to be assessed – e.g. exams, class work, attendance, project work, team work, grading scheme etc.
<b>Schedule</b>	The timetable for class contact with lecturers, tutors, labs, assessments etc.
<b>Rooms and Facilities</b>	The suitability of the space provided for teaching, tutorials, labs etc.


7. If the following message appears, you have skipped a survey question(s). Click on **OK**, answer the skipped question(s), then click **Submit**.




8. You will see confirmation that your evaluation has been submitted and a list of modules to be evaluated. To evaluate another module click "**here**".



9. Select the next module that you wish to evaluate, repeat steps 5 and 6 until you have evaluated all modules.




10. When you have evaluated the final module you will see the following. Click on Close to Exit the survey.
