

### MIC Reduced Points places for DARE & HEAR Admission Scheme 2020

**Please Note - These numbers are for guideline purposes only and may vary from year to year. MIC reserves a quota of reduced points places for eligible HEAR and DARE applicants who do not achieve the CAO points for their chosen programme. In order to compete for one of these places, applicants must meet all the admissions criteria, achieve a minimum of 300 CAO points and come within a differential of 40 points below the CAO cut-off. Participating HEIs have agreed to prioritise DARE students with physical and sensory disabilities and students who are eligible for both schemes.**
